

## Mobilize on the fly your Oracle PeopleSoft HCM site

**H**CMobilizer will convert, on the fly, your PeopleSoft HCM website to a mobile or tablet friendly app.

No need to change anything to your PeopleSoft Architecture or Configuration with this WebView based app since the transformation does not take place at the PeopleSoft Server level but rather at the Client level, i.e. your mobile device, by simply converting your PeopleSoft website to a Mobile website.

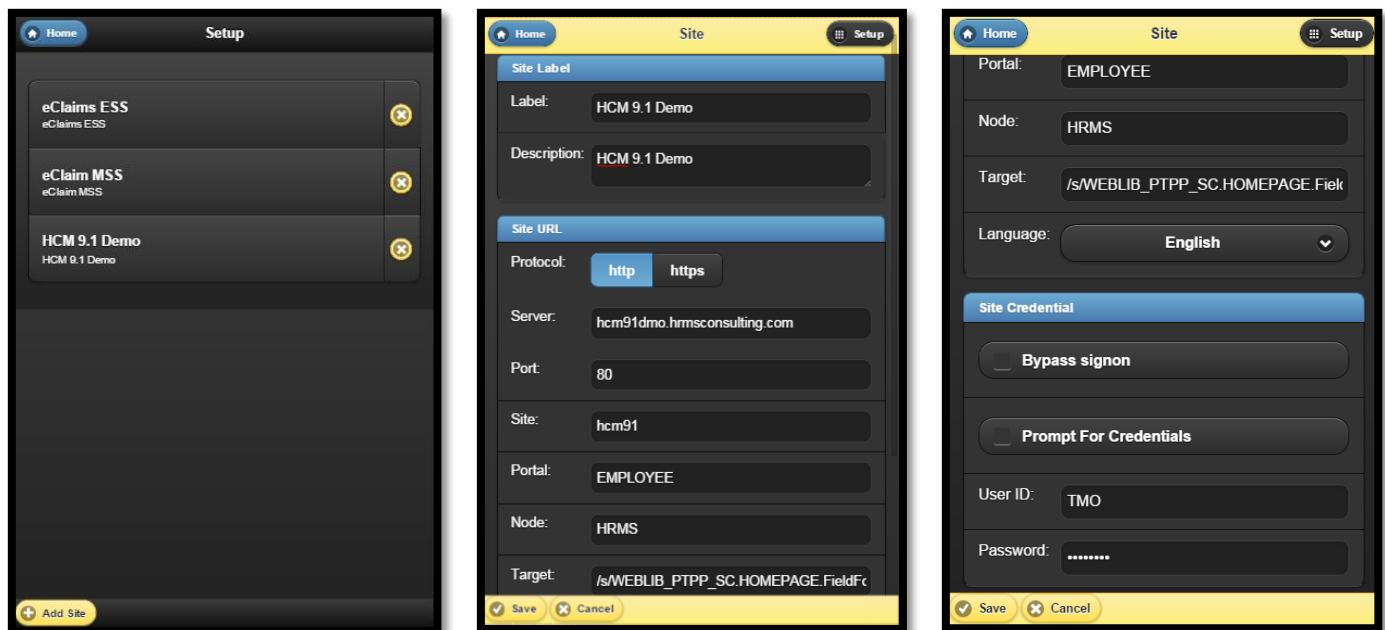
A free Ad-supported version of HCMobilizer is available on Google Play and App Store.



HCMobilizer is currently working on PeopleSoft HCM 9.0 and up (Tools Release 8.51 and up).

A Branded and/or Custom WebView app, better tailored to your specific needs, can easily and rapidly be built using HCMobilizer core JavaScript transformation engine.

## Simple Setup



You can setup as many HCMobilizer sites as you want by simply providing your Default PeopleSoft HCM URL.

Keep in mind that standard homepage URLs on PeopleSoft HCM have the following structure:

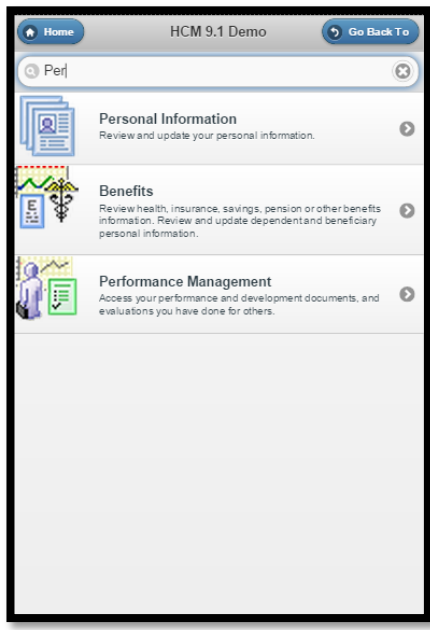
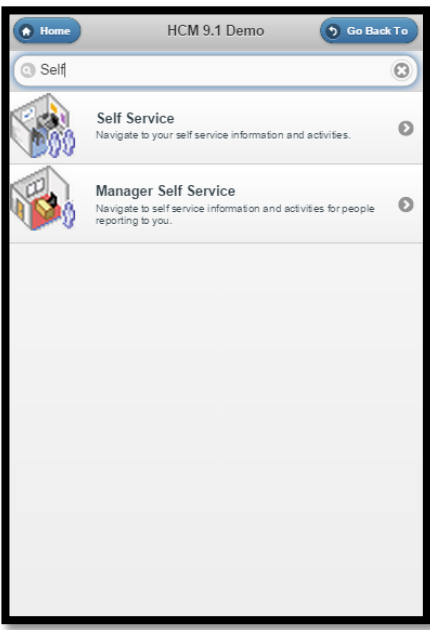

<b>Prompt for Credentials</b>	Check if you don't want to store your credentials but have the App prompt for your credential before accessing your site.
<b>User ID</b>	User ID
<b>Password</b>	Password

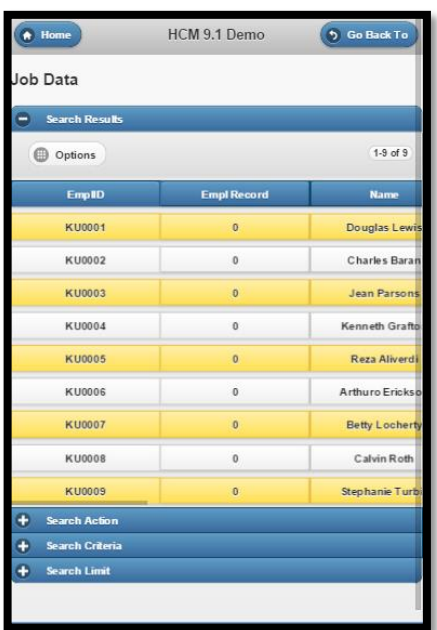
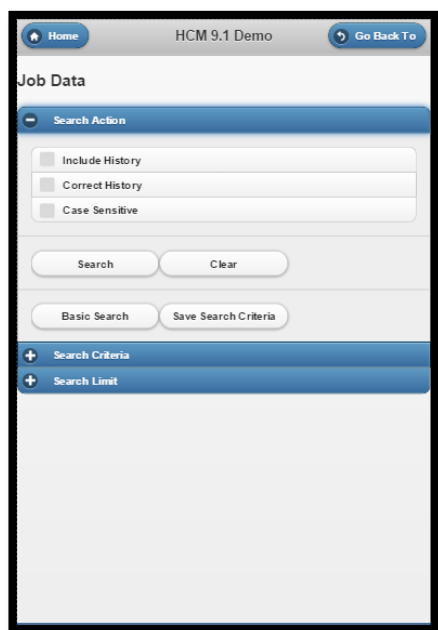
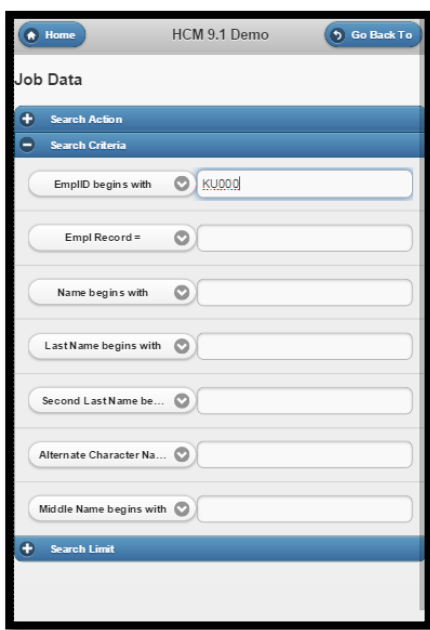

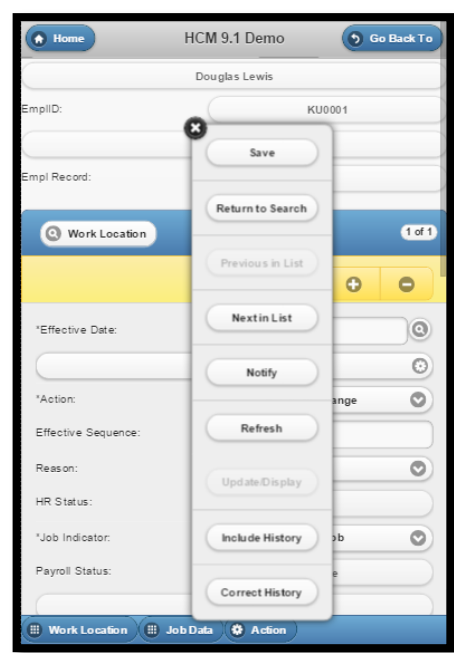
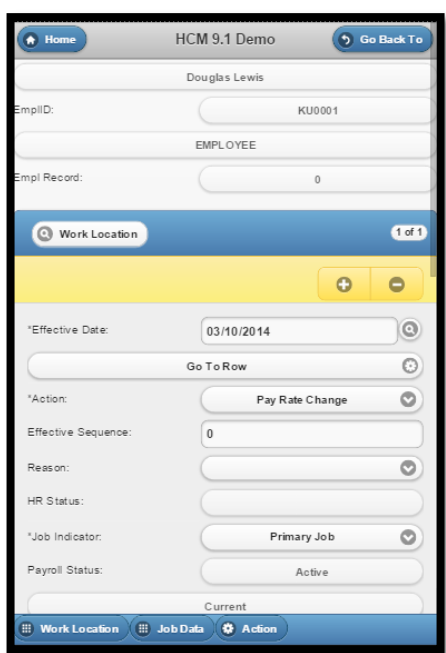
